The University has established collaboration with NIELIT to start a research centre at the University campus. For this, a centre at the University premises has already been allotted to the NIELIT. It is a central govt. Initiative and in near future, the students of the University and students of other affiliated colleges of the division will get the benefit. On the recommendations of IQAC, MoUs between the University and Rajasthan ILD Skills University, Jaipur on 22 Jun 2020, Bhupal Nobles' University, Udaipur on 22 Jun 2021, and Rameshwaram Institute of Technology and Management, Lucknow on 27 Aug 2021 have been established.

2. Improvement of ICT facilities and Up-gradation of existing classrooms into Smart-Class Rooms

Each Department of the University has at least one Smart Board and Digital Podium (Lecture Capture) installed in their classrooms. The Smart Board and Digital Podium have been also installed in other sections/cells of the University including the Academic Hall at the VC Secretariat (a total of seventeen in number). Proper training has been given to all teaching and non-teaching staff for handling smart boards and digital podiums.

3. Green practices and Environmental audit

- i. The university has adopted the 'Green Campus' system for environmental conservation and sustainability. There are main three pillars i.e. zero environmental footprints, positive impact on occupant health and performance, and 100% graduates demonstrating environmental literacy. The goal is to reduce CO₂ emission, energy, and water use while creating an atmosphere where students can learn and be healthy. The University has planted-solar panels on its campus and is the only State University taking this mission ahead. Surrounded by the Green corridor, the solar lights have added to the beauty of the campus as the dazzling campus looks extremely impressive and beautiful during the night hours. The University is thus making a significant contribution towards 'Save Environment, Save the Earth'.

- ii. The University has developed state of a art infrastructure. A magnificent Students' Service Centre equipped with the telephone, photo state, e-mitra, and toilet facilities has become operational. Located in a serene atmosphere, the University is environmentally sensitive and has founded several parks and a zone – Junagarh Oxygen zone, Smriti Park (Near canteen), Eco-park (Near VC Secretariat) Sanskriti Park (Near admin Block), IT Park. 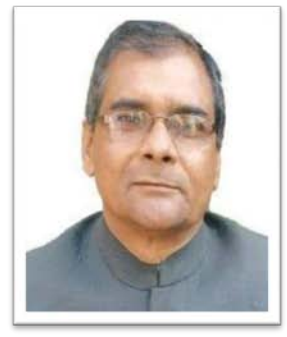

- To ensure transparency in the University and to complete the digitalization of administrative works for the convenience of the students.

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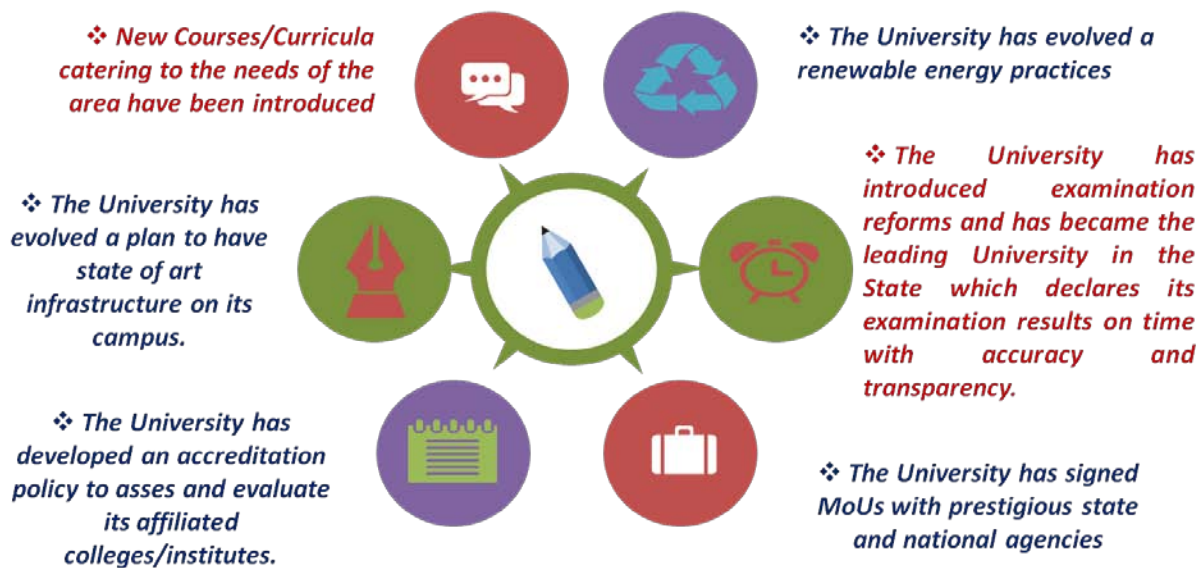
