5. SFS programmes to be run on campus

It was decided that the SFS programmes to be run on campus in the session 2022-23 in which less than 50% of the allotted seats are filled, the SFS program will not be continued.

6. Admission notification 2022-23

It was resolved to prepare admission notification for all UG/PG/Diploma/Certificate programmes to be run on the campus for the session 2022-2023. It is decided that the notification would be published on 30 June 2022 in all the leading regional and national newspapers as well as in the Employment News. It was also decided that the admission notification 2022-23 would be sent to all Universities/Colleges in India and nearby countries for the display of the notification on the students' notice board.

7. Outsourcing of Admission Process

To look at the recurring nature of admission-form preparation and requirement of filling it by online mode (at all levels e.g. first application, second and third application on vacant seats) by the prospective students, admission inquiries, various notifications to all applicants, and its related processes, etc, it was decided that the process would be outsourced. For this the format of the ONLINE admission form will be finalized.

8. Empanelment of the lectures/guest faculty

It was resolved that the notification for the empanelment of the lectures/guest faculty will be prepared and it would be published in all the newspapers of the Bikaner edition. The same would be notified on the University Webpage. The details of the required qualifications and the application form for the same will be prepared. Instructions were given to the website in charge to upload the information related to admission 2022-23 on the University using the website pop-up as well.


9. SFS Centralized Office

In the meeting it was discussed to set up a centralized office for self-financing programmes. This office's function will be to provide a centralised administrative framework for managing all facets of the University's self-financing programmes. This will guarantee effective management, effective coordination, and efficient administration of various programmes.

10. To upgrade the laboratory facilities by acquiring advanced equipment

It was decided that the science laboratories of the University will be equipped with more number of advanced Instruments. By making more cutting-edge tools available, the goal is to improve the laboratories' capabilities and quality. With this improvement, students will have access to a greater variety of cutting-edge equipment and technology. A decision was made to float a tender for the acquisition of laboratory equipment in the department of Microbiology and environmental science.
